The cost is \$7/person and average tour time is 1 hour. Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday are best at farm. Spring is optimal season, winter is weather permitting, and fall is all about pumpkins.

Throughout its long history Rancho Camulos has had a diverse and rich agricultural history. The first oranges grown and shipped commercially from what is now Ventura County were from the Camulos Ranch in 1876. In addition to the annual crops of citrus, almonds, walnuts, apricots, peaches, wheat, corn and barley. Grapevines were also cultivated at Camulos for the production of wine and brandy. Regular tours are Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday, with a suggested donation of \$5 for adults and \$3 for children. Fruit stand on premises. Tour length: 1 hour.
